





2.7.1 STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY


For the NAAC AQAR (2019-20), Students Satisfaction Survey (SSS) was conducted among the students of the college through Google form. The institution framed a questionnaire based on NAAC guidelines to get a feedback solely on teaching -learning process. The questionnaire included twenty one questions out of which twenty were objective questions, designed to rate on a scale of 4 to 0 from most positive to most negative and one was an open ended question for providing valuable suggestions/observations. The result of this survey is based on the response of 471 students.




Gender

What subject area are you currently pursuing?




- All questions should be compulsorily attempted.


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?






7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.








10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.




11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.




12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.




13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.




14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.




15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.




16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.




17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.




18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.
