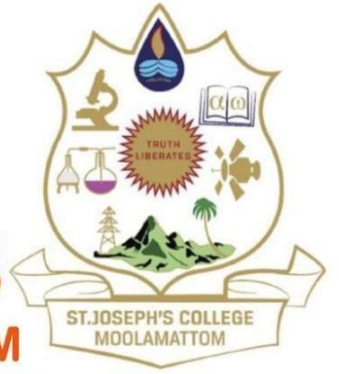

Venue: St. Joseph's College, Moolamattom

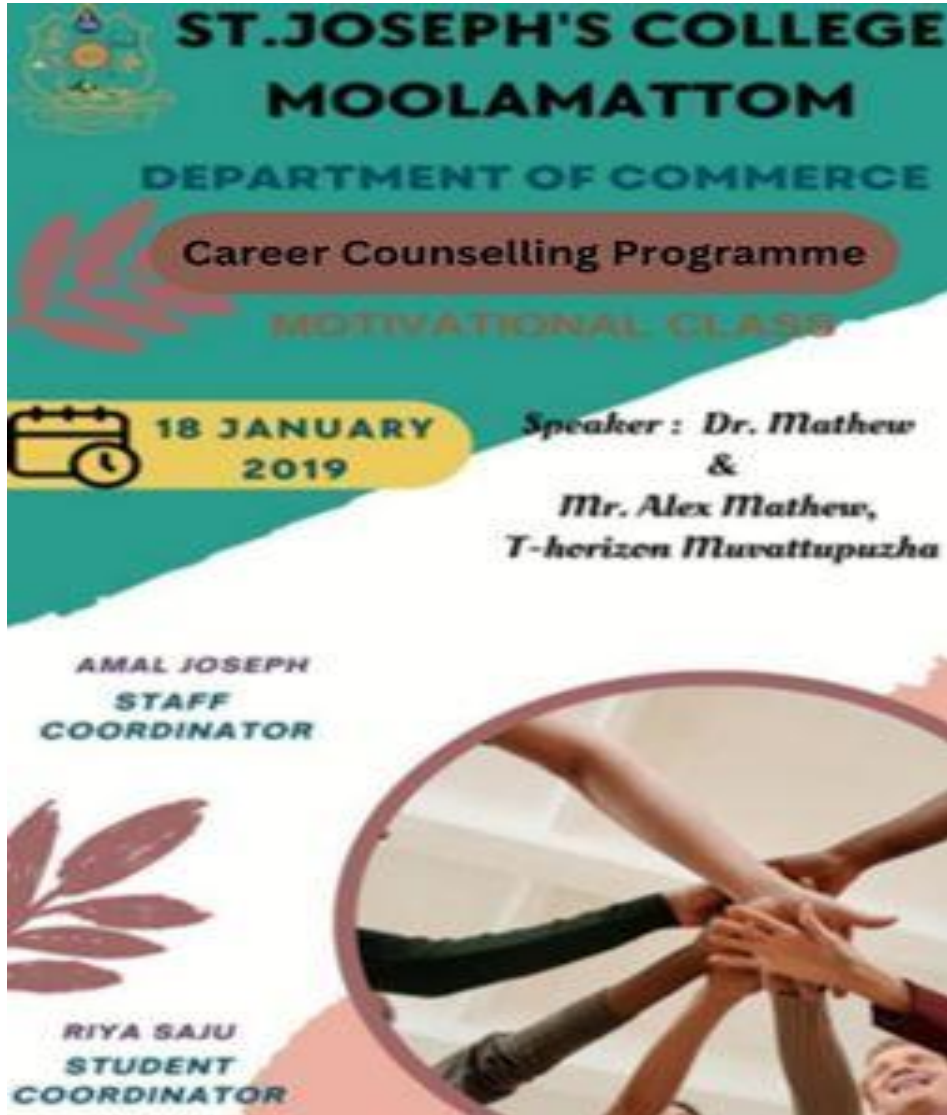
Resource Person: Dr. Mathew and Mr. Alex Mathew, T Horizon Muvattupuzha

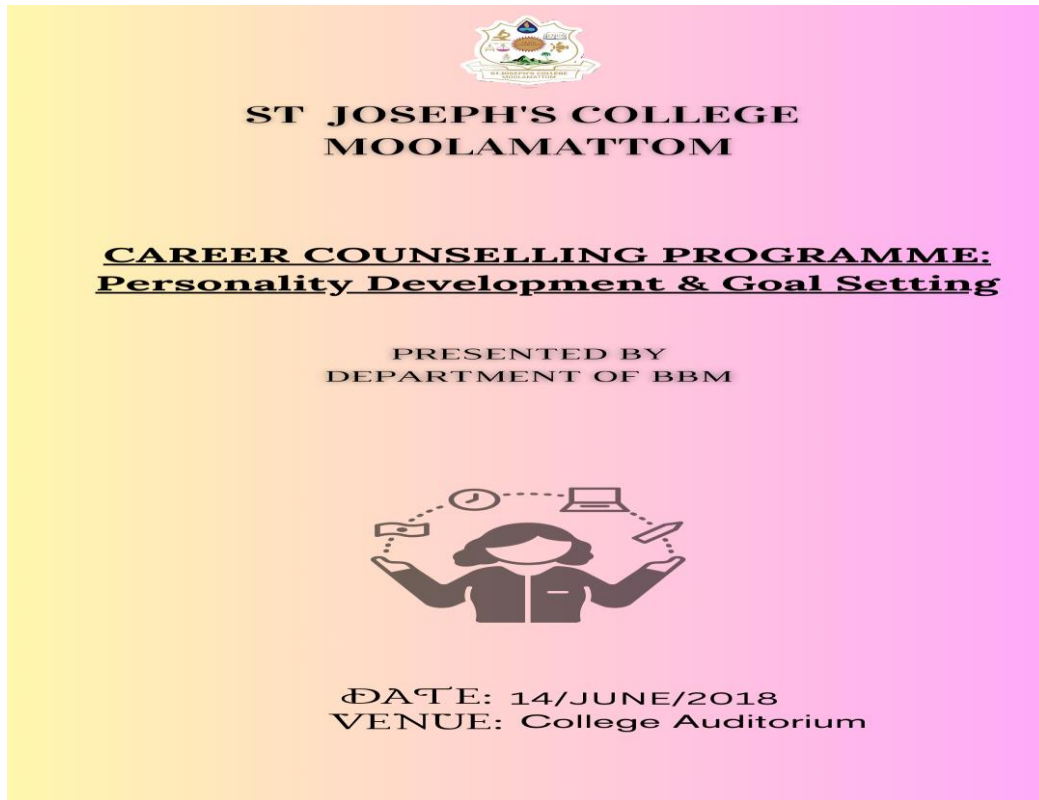

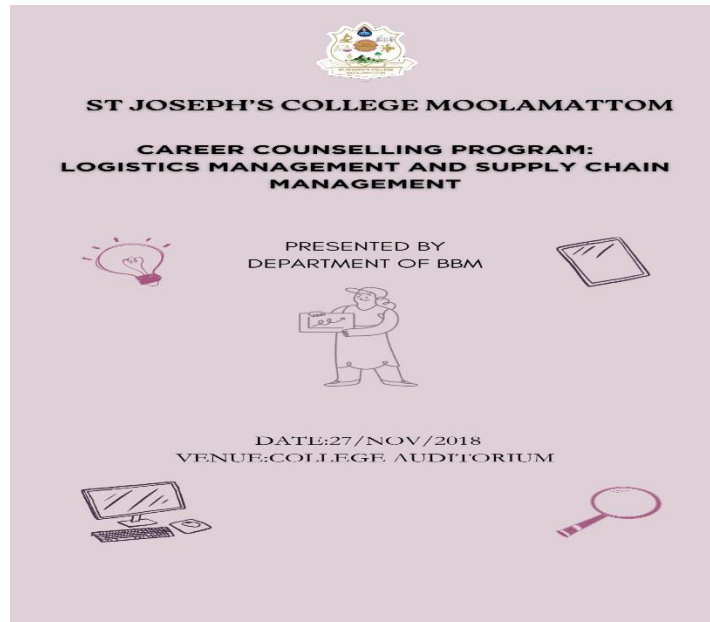
