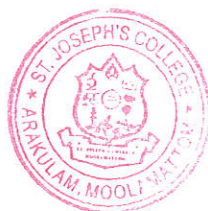

Students	Students suggested to include more activities to link theoretical classes with industrial knowledge.	To address the concerns of the students, each department introduced industrial based add-on courses and ensured that industrial visit and field visit are made part of the curriculum.
Teachers	Respondents observed that the current PG syllabus must incorporate the recent updates in the respective programmes.	Teachers represented departments in PG Syllabus Restructuring Workshops and conveyed necessary modifications in the syllabus.
Employers	Employers requested for more exposure for methods for enhancing the communication skills and other life skills of the students, as the employers observed that the employees lack communication skills and life skills.	To address the concerns of the employers, Peer Teaching, cross- teaching and group discussions were introduced in all the batches.

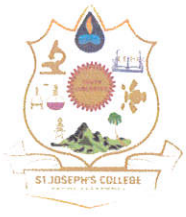

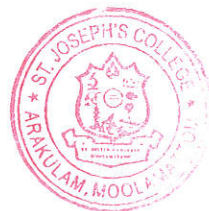

Students	Students expressed their concern that they were in need of reduced screen time in the wake of online classes.	The College Council reformulated class timings with enough intervals in between. The new adjustments made the online mode of learning a more comfortable affair.
Teachers	Many responses highlighted the need for installation of more ICT facilities to cope with the pandemic crisis.	Installed internet switches in every department. In addition to that management provides financial assistance to teachers to attend FDPs on ICT tools.
Employers	Respondents expressed in their feedback the concern for improving students' knowledge base of their respective subjects	To address the concerns of the employers, every department took up initiatives to improve knowledge of students through various strategies like enrichment programme, remedial coaching, value added courses and blended classes, etc.....

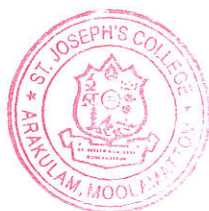

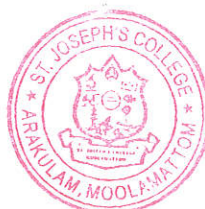
